Our chair, Scott Somohano, had to step down due to family health issues. And Harry Sanger, our Land Use and Transportation rep, accepted a job offer out of state.

We thank them for devoting their personal time to making Portland a better place, and we wish them both much happiness and success in the challenges and opportunities they face.

Due to their departures, we have two important vacancies on the SAN board: Chair and Land Use/Transportation. A few details:

- **Chair:** Filled by appointment. Hold the gavel during board meetings and monthly general meetings. Help to set the agenda for those meetings. Help to line up guest speakers of interest. Coach and encourage other volunteers on their roles and projects.
- **Transportation:** Filled by appointment. Attend the monthly Land Use Transportation committee (LUTC) meeting held by Central Northeast Neighbors (CNN). Identify projects and trends of interest to Sumner neighborhood.

Because of the variety of projects Scott and Harry minded for SAN, there are other opportunities to fill. They include:

- **82nd Avenue Improvement Coalition:** An inter-neighborhood group working to make 82nd Avenue more city thoroughfare and less state highway.
- **Comprehensive Plan Update:** A new draft is due this summer. Synching our neighborhood plan with it will pay dividends for years.

- **Killingsworth onramp project:** The city promised to keep us in the loop. Nothing yet.
- **Quarterly newsletter:** Write articles & line up ads.

What is OK to Bring?

Yard debris including small branches, furniture, windows, carpet, scrap metal, washers/dryers, toilets, mattresses, mowers (gas and oil removed), wood stoves, bikes, tubs, toys, stereos, VCR's We recycle your old cell phones and used ink cartridges. Scott's Recycling will take your appliances and scrap metal!

What NOT to Bring!

No Hazardous Waste: gasoline, chemicals, oil, paint, tar, batteries, animal waste or liquids of any kind. Do not bring the following building and landscape materials: concrete, asphalt, dirt, sod, brick, cement, sand, gravel or roofing, asbestos material and under the sink garbage!



Clean UP Fees/donations

Residential vehicles only, No commercial vehicles will be accepted.

Car: \$7.00 • Van, small truck loads or SUV: \$15.00

Large Pickup trucks: \$20.00 • oversized vehicles will be charged an additional fee

Tires are extra: \$2.00 off rim, \$3.00 on rim
