## NOTIFICATION: Upcoming Rose Lane Project and On-Street Parking Impacts

Dear Resident/Property Owner:

Prior to the current state of emergency, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) was planning on adding a new bus-and-turn (BAT) Lane for eastbound vehicles on NE Sandy Blvd from NE 88th Ave to NE 90th Ave in May 2020 to reduce congestion and transit delay as part of the Rose Lane Project.

Rose Lanes are corridors where transit priority treatments are used to get buses and streetcars out of traffic in locations with high transit delay, thereby increasing transit speed and reliability across the city. Each project location was identified through careful analysis of city-wide transit and traffic data; and the most appropriate treatment was selected to best address the unique needs and context of the site.

Near you, we will be adding a BAT Lane on NE Sandy Blvd for eastbound traffic. The new BAT Lane will create space for exclusive use by buses, and vehicles accessing adjacent businesses and turning southbound/right onto NE Prescott St from NE Sandy Blvd. The BAT Lane will reduce the congestion from right-turning vehicles blocking the thru lane. Additionally, buses will benefit from the dedicated transit lane.

NE Sandy Blvd will be realigned to accommodate these changes and on-street parking will be impacted in areas adjacent to the project area. Existing "No Parking" signs will be updated to the new standards, and new signs will be added to clarify the extents of the no parking zone and BAT Lane on both sides of the street:

- Eastbound: The BAT Lane and no parking zone will extend from NE 88th Ave – NE 90th Ave
- Westbound: The no parking zone will extend from 200-ft west of NE 88th Ave to NE 91st Ave

The new BAT Lane configuration and parking signs are scheduled to be installed in June 2020. Our construction crews will provide a second notification letter once the project schedule is confirmed.
